

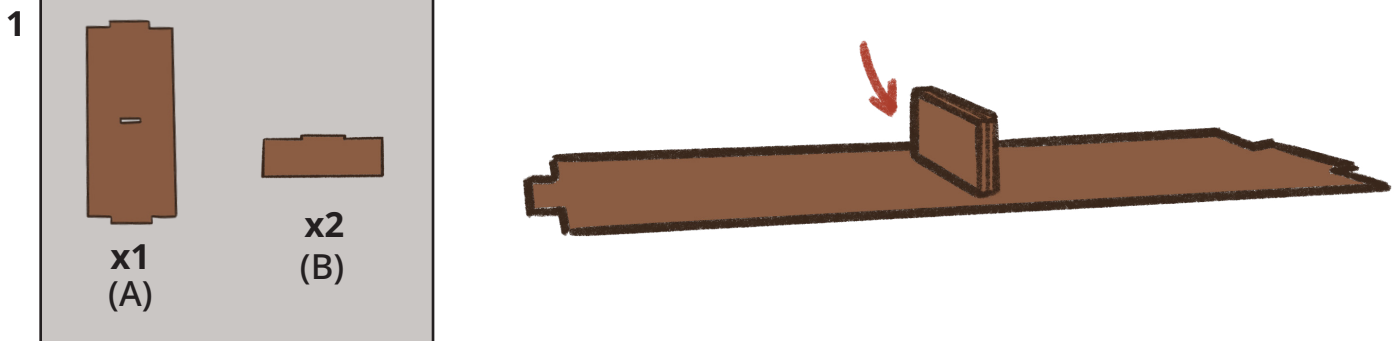
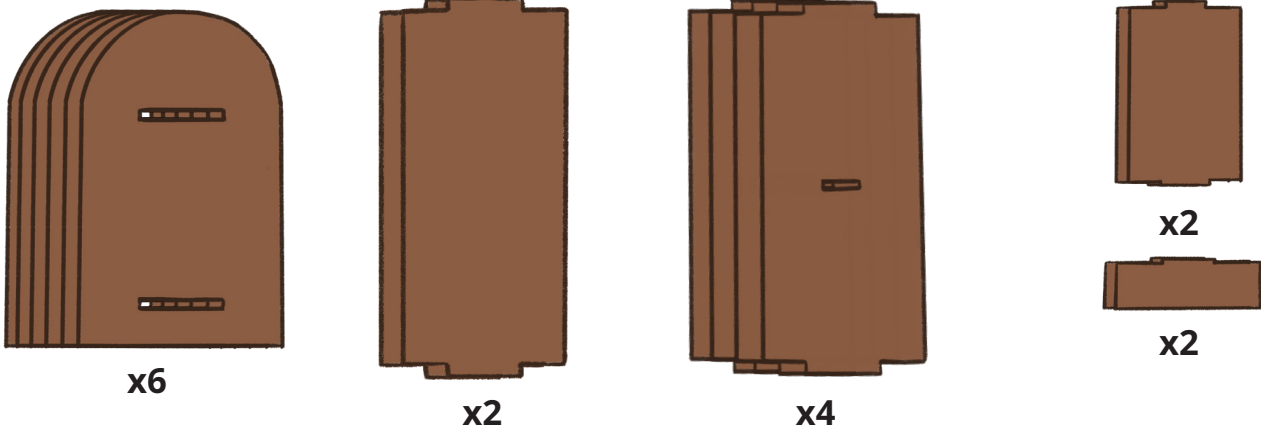

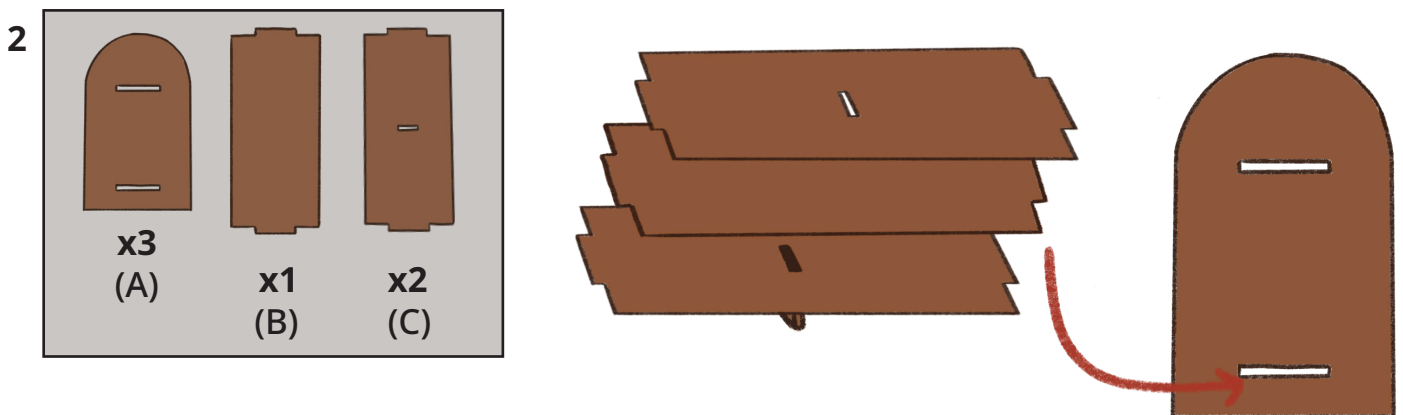
Assembly Guide

Note: While this can be assembled by 1 person, we recommend having 2 people for the easiest assembly process.

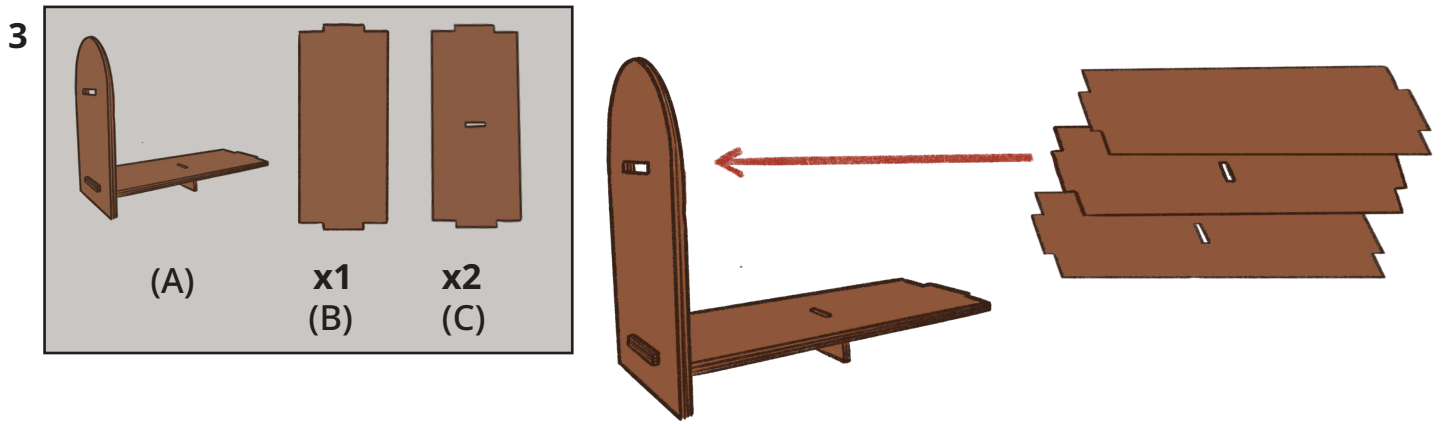
Materials



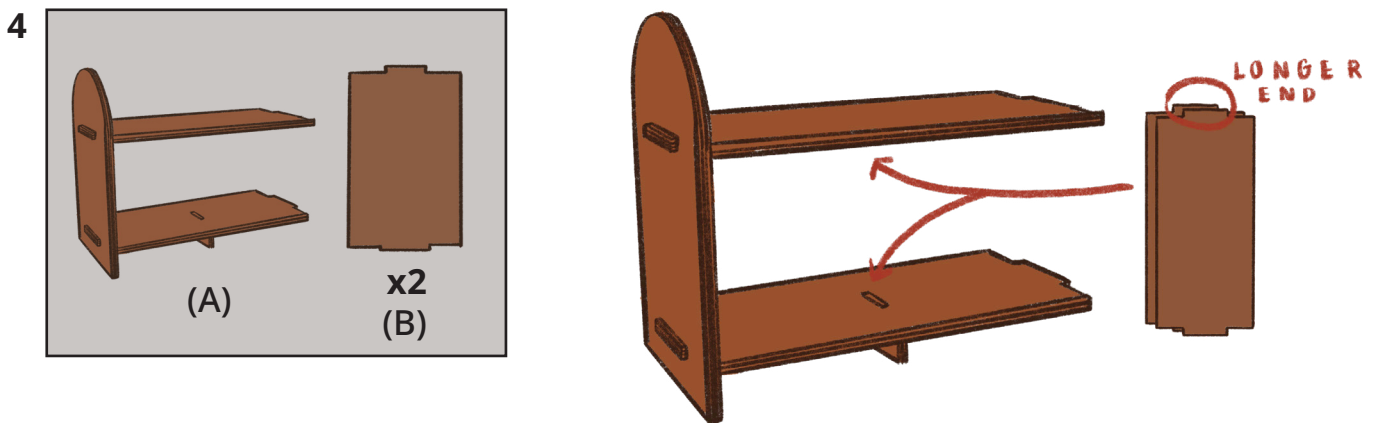
Hold the two B pieces back to back and use a rubber mallet to gently tap the pieces into the slot of part A.



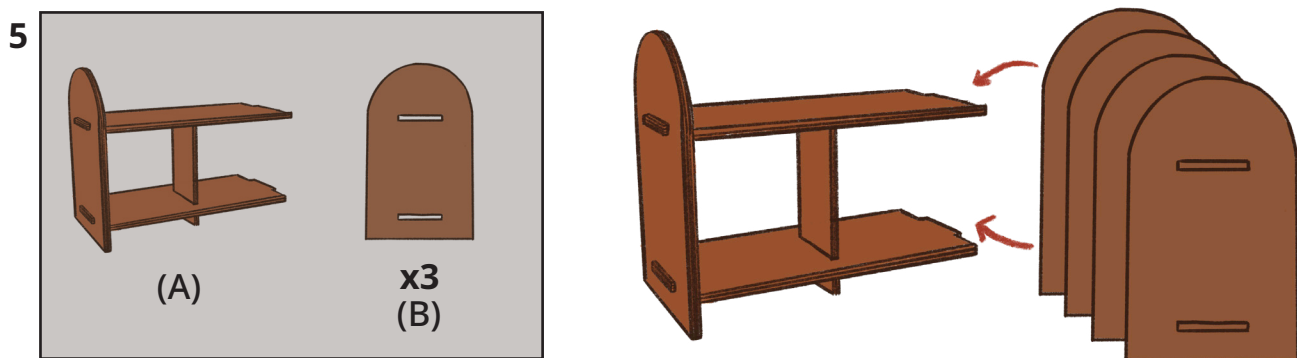
Line up the 3 side pieces (A) so they are stacked on each other. The holes should line up. Insert a B and C pieces into the bottom slot shown above. Then slide the final C piece into the slot, some force, moving back and forth, or light usage of a rubber mallet may be needed.



With the A piece flat against the table in a stable position, insert a B and C pieces into the top slot shown above. Then slide the final C piece into the slot, some force, moving back and forth, or light usage of a rubber mallet may be needed.



Hold the two B pieces back to back and gently slide the pieces into the slot of part A.



Make sure piece A is laying flat against the table -- the shelf pieces should be vertical and the curved side should be flat. Side the B pieces one by one into the slots creating a symmetrical build. Some force, moving back and forth, or light usage of a rubber mallet may be needed.
